Mystery of the Trim Trail Solved By Louise Simmons

Have you noticed a strange new object in front of the nature garden? A giant green bowl sitting on its side, as if left over from a dinosaur's dinner. Perhaps you've sat on the seat at the bottom and wondered what it was and how it got there. When you find out what it does you'll be desperate to go back and try it for yourself.

Hitherfield School is the lucky recipient of a unique scientific sculpture that has for the last year or so been a feature of the Natural History Museum's wildlife garden, where I work.

Created as a prototype for the museum's Urban Nature Project, the installation was designed to focus the sounds of nature.

An acoustic mirror focuses sound in the same way that a concave glass mirror focuses light: sound waves directed straight on to the bowl are reflected by the smooth surface, and every point on the curve sends the sound to the same point, positioned just where your ears are when you're sitting on the built-in bench. Ask someone to retreat as far as they can, staying in a line with the front surface of the mirror, and then to talk quietly. You'll hear every word as if they were whispering in your ear.

The Urban Nature Project is an ambitious project to transform the Museum's 5 acre site into a living, outdoor gallery split into two parts – the *Nature Discovery Garden* to the west of the historic Waterhouse building encouraging people to engage with the environment around them and learn about climate change, and the *Evolution Garden* to the east which tells the story of deep time over 3.2 billion years of evolution through geology, "living fossil" plants and a life size bronze *Diplodocus carnegii*. I won't give any more spoilers here but there are many other surprises lurking in the ancient coal forests and *Jurassic Garden*. You'll just have to come along from the 18th July when the gardens open to the public to experience it for yourselves.
