

What: 6 mornings of fun-filled Maths Explorers challenges, strategy games, board games and free play. You can choose which mornings to book.

When: 8.30am to 12pm on Tuesday 30th July, Wednesday 31st July, Thursday 1st August 2024, Tuesday 6th August, Wednesday 7th August & Thursday 8th August

Who is it for: School-going and home-educated young people in Years 3 to 6 (KS2/ approx age 7/8yrs to 11yrs). Young people from any school are welcome to sign on.

Who is most likely to enjoy it: Our camps are a very relaxed and calm exploring & play space. Young people who love mathematical & logical puzzles, games & challenges and who are happy to spend their time weaving in and out of focussed challenge time and more relaxed free play time with games and other resources are most likely to enjoy it. We take a 25 minute break in the middle of each session for the young people to have a supervised run around in the playground. However, young people who need more intense physical and active fun during holidays may be less likely to enjoy the space and activities we provide.

Can you be a reading Hitherfield Hero?

This year and last year we have had incredible success with our Hitherfield Hero reading programme, ensuring every class in the school had a volunteer reader from the community at least once a week! This had an incredible impact on our readers and we want to do that again next year (starting September 2024)!

We are calling on anyone who is able to donate at least 30 minutes a week of their time to the school (either 9-9.30am or 3-3.30pm) to help children learn to and enjoy reading.

In each class, from Reception to Year 6, there are children who need YOUR help to maximise their progress.

You would be assigned a class, and listen to three children read once a week on a day to suit you. This one-toone reading has an incredible impact- just five minutes reading a day can make a huge difference to fluency and comprehension!

Sadly, with the cuts to education funding, the school has less and less staff in order to provide this one-on-one, support. This is why we need **YOU**!
