We will be saying a big thank you and good luck to Julia, one of our SENDCos, at the end of January. Julia has been at Hitherfield for 10.5 years, starting as a teacher and then moving into the SENDCo role. Julia has supported many children in their learning and worked with lots of families to ensure their child gets the support needed. We wish Julia all the best in her new role within Lambeth's Special Education Needs department.

We are pleased to inform you that the SENDCo role will be filled by Unta. Unta is already a member of the school community, as a parent and parent governor, and she is an experienced school SENDCo and senior leader. Unta will be starting at Hitherfield on Monday 20th January and will work alongside Julia for the remainder of the month, so that they can have a smooth handover.

Is my child too ill for school? Vomiting and Diarrhoea (V&D)

Children with Vomiting and Diarrhoea should stay away from school until they have not been sick or had diarrhoea for at least 2 days (48 hours). This is in line with NHS guidance. Vomiting and Diarrhoea can spread easily which is why we ask parents to stick to the guidelines.

High temperature - If your child has a high temperature, keep them off school until it goes away. A high temperature is 38C or more.

Chickenpox - If your child has <u>chickenpox</u>, keep them off school until all the spots have crusted over. This is usually about 5 days after the spots first appeared.


