School Cuts – Ongoing inpact.

It has been my pleasure and honour to be in my 19th year of headship at Hitherifeld Primary School. I honestly believe I have one of the best jobs in the world. Unfortunately, since 2010 schools across England have seen real term cuts in their budgets. As a school we have managed these cuts for many years by not replacing staff as they have left and gradually reducing the amount we spend on resources. We have become increasingly reliant on the PTA and parental donations for some basics, such as reading books, and for improvements to the astroturf and other play equipment.

Unlike many schools in Lambeth and across the country who are in financial deficit, we have managed to maintain a positive financial position. However, these real term cuts are now reaching a point where even we may struggle to remain in a strong financial position going forward. In the last two years we have seen futher unfunded staff pay increases, which are expected to continue again next year. Pension and national insurance costs incurred by the school have rapidly increased and, as I am sure you will know, gas and electric bills have increased 50%, as have many other associated costs such as cleaning and maintenace.


Sadly, even with a change in government, there appears to be no signs of this financial pressure improving. I have therefore decided to throw myself behind the Stop School Cuts campaign. Many of you may have seen the posters around the school or even had a flyer sent home. The Stop School Cuts campaign highlights the amount of real terms cuts our school has had to deal with in the table below. Things have to change, so I have agreed to take part in a short film to support the campaign. You may see a camera crew on the school site on Monday 24th March, especially around the Leigham Vale entrance in the morning. We will be filming in the school that day. No child will be featured in the film, but they may appear in the background, so please inform the admin school office if you do not want your child to appear.
