FREE CYCLE TRAINING

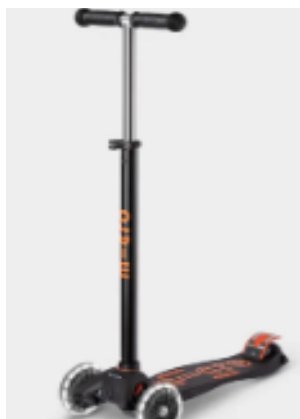
Lambeth Council with Cycle Confident are running FREE cycle training for children in the Easter holidays at Clapham Common.

There are 2-hour sessions for beginners who would like to learn to ride or come off stabilisers, as well as 8-hour (over 4 days) courses for the over-nines who are confident riders and would like to learn some on-road skills. Children are encouraged to bring their own bikes but there are also bikes available to borrow. With Noel Gardner from the Lambeth Autism Advisory Service

These workshops are for families in Lambeth who have an autistic child, or those who are on the pathway to obtaining a diagnosis.

The session, Understanding Behaviour, will cover the following areas:

- To consider what may trigger a behaviour(s) and what steps can be taken to avoid behaviours
- Begin to understand differences in behaviour and the causes of these behaviours.
- Understand the 'acting out cycle'.
- Explore tools to analyse behaviour and think about solutions.
- To explore a range of positive strategies.
